SUNDAY OF DIVINE MERCY



On this [Sunday of Divine Mercy](#), the Gospel recounts that the disciples remained in deep fear after Jesus' death on the cross. They stayed behind locked doors for fear of religious authorities, expecting the same fate as their master. It was at this moment of utter fear and isolation that Jesus appears to the disciples, saying to them, "Peace be with you." Then Jesus shows them his hands and his side, the unmistakable signs of his self-giving love in his death on the cross.

The disciples' fear turns to hope-filled rejoicing in the presence of the Lord. And when Jesus breathes on them, bestowing on them the gift of the Holy Spirit, they leave behind the chains of fear. The same fearful disciples become bold missionary witnesses to faith. They encountered divine mercy in the person of Jesus and became instruments of divine mercy to the world. The Holy Spirit is the third person of the Blessed Trinity, the love of the Father and the Son whose presence sanctifies and vivifies the church in every age. At Pentecost the entire church receives the Holy Spirit that Jesus first promised to his disciples. Today, that same Holy Spirit is offered as gift to every disciple of Jesus so we might face and overcome the fears, anxieties and worries of life. In the power of the Holy Spirit, we are strengthened to replace fear with faith and exchange the anxieties and worries of daily life with confident trust in God.

The Holy Spirit invites us today and every day to leave behind our fears and live in the freedom of friendship with Jesus, as we pray in faith, "Speak to me, Lord."

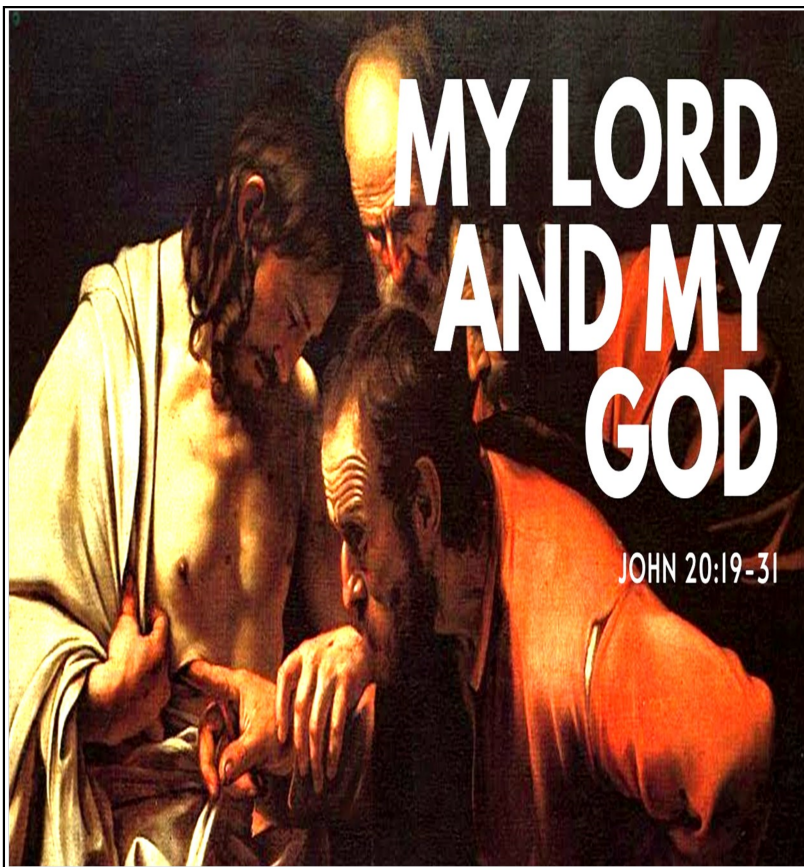

¿Cuándo debe rezarse la Divina Misericordia?

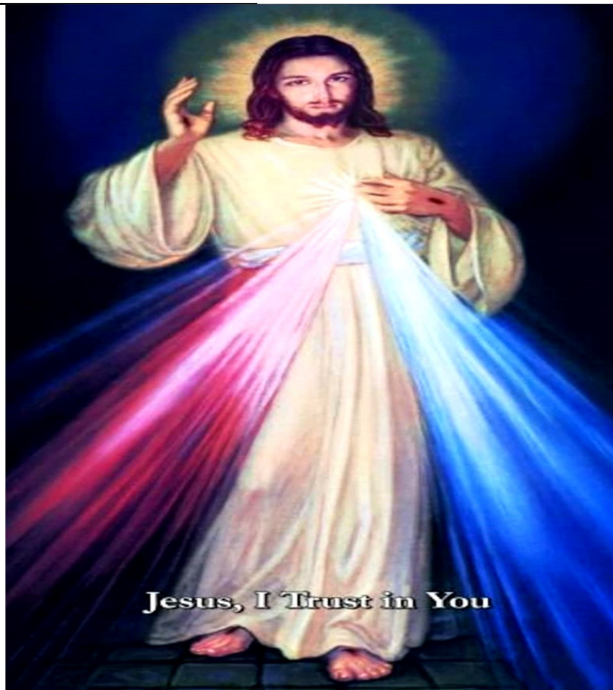
Así como la imagen sirve para recordar el "océano de Misericordia divina" y su precio, así también la memoria diaria de la Divina Misericordia a la hora de la muerte de Cristo.

Jesús pidió a Santa Faustina, y a todos nosotros a través de ella, que celebremos la Hora de la Gran Misericordia, con la promesa de gracias inmensas para quienes lo hagan pidiendo por ellos mismos o por otras personas.

A las tres, ruega por Mi misericordia, en especial para los pecadores y aunque solo sea por un brevísimo momento, sumérgete en Mi Pasión, especialmente en Mi abandono en el momento de Mi agonía. Esta es la hora de la gran misericordia... En esta hora nada le será negado al alma que lo pida por los méritos de Mi Pasión. (Diario, 1320)

¿Por qué es tan importante el horario de las 3 para rezar la devoción a la Divina Misericordia?

En los Evangelios, se nos dice que Jesús murió a la hora nona (cf. Mt. 27,46-50) del día de la Preparación para la Pascua (cf. Mt. 27,62, Jn 19,14) en un año que, además, era Sabático (cf. Jn 19,31). Esto marca la hora de la muerte de Jesús como la hora nona (según la hora solar), o 3 de la tarde, un día viernes (ya que el sabbat judío es el sábado). Esta es la hora de la Gran Misericordia y la hora en la cual, bajo la vieja alianza, se sacrificaba al Cordero Pascual.



When should Divine Mercy be prayed?

Just as the image serves to recall the "ocean of divine mercy" and its price, so too does the daily remembrance of the Divine Mercy at the hour of Christ's death.

Jesus asked St. Faustina, and all of us through her, to celebrate the Hour of Great Mercy, with the promise of im-

mense graces for those who do so by asking for themselves or for others.

At three o'clock, pray for My mercy, especially for sinners, and even if only for a very brief moment, immerse yourself in My Passion, especially in My abandonment in the moment of My agony. This is the hour of great mercy... In this hour nothing will be denied to the soul that asks for it through the merits of My Passion. (Diary, 1320)

Why is the 3 o'clock time so important for praying devotion to Divine Mercy?

In the Gospels, we are told that Jesus died at the ninth hour (cf. Mt 27:46-50) on the day of Preparation for the Passover (cf. Mt 27:62, Jn 19:14) in a year that was also a Sabbatical (cf. Jn 19:31). This marks the hour of Jesus' death as the ninth hour (according to solar time), or 3 p.m., on a Friday day (since the Jewish Sabbath is the Sabbath). This is the hour of Great Mercy and the hour in which, under the old covenant, the Paschal Lamb was sacrificed.
