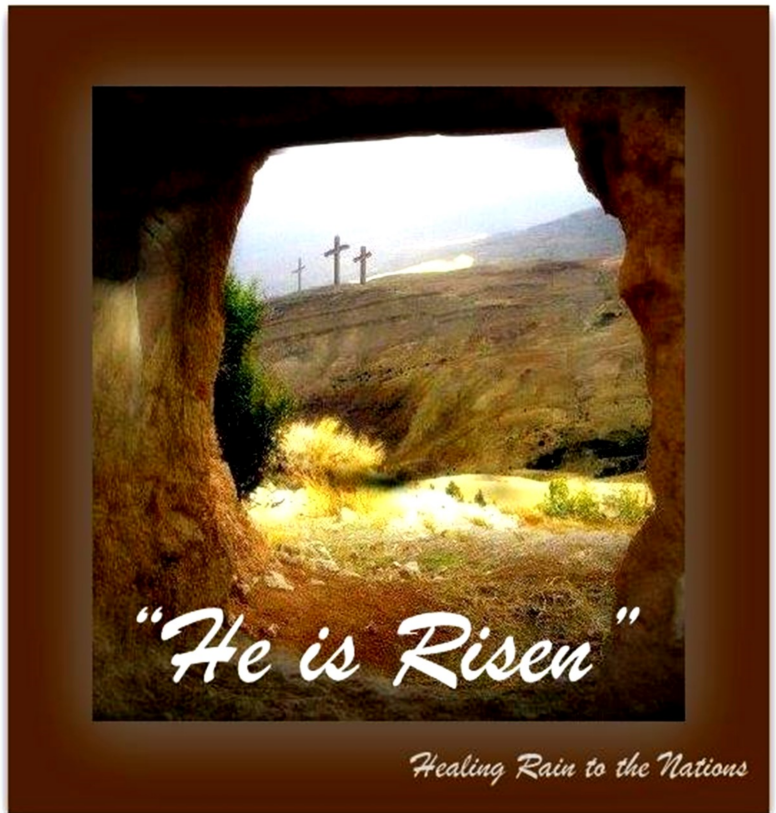

CONFIRMATION

Each year, Bishop Robert Brennan, extends a special privilege (*'indult'*) to the Pastors of the church, to celebrate the sacrament of *'Confirmation'* with those *'adults,'* who for various reasons, have never been confirmed. The special privilege can only be exercised on the *Feast of Pentecost*, when the Church celebrates the gift of the Holy Spirit. This year the *Feast of Pentecost is May 19th*, and we will be celebrating the *Sacrament of Confirmation at the 11:00am Mass.*

For those *'adults'* who have been *'Baptized,'* who have perhaps also received the *'First Holy Communion,'* but have never been *'Confirmed,'* please contact Fr. Orlando at the Parish Office for additional information and requirements. This is important especially for those persons who have been asked to be a sponsor for another person's confirmation, or if you plan to marry in the near future. You need to be a *'Confirmed Christian'* yourself, before you can be a sponsor for someone, or in order to be married in the Catholic Church.

CONFIRMACIÓN

Cada año, el Obispo Robert Brennan, extiende un privilegio especial (*'indulto'*) a los Pastores de la Iglesia, para celebrar el sacramento de la *'Confirmación'* con aquellos *'adultos'*, que por diversas razones, nunca han sido confirmados. El privilegio especial sólo puede ejercerse en la *fiesta de Pentecostés*, cuando la Iglesia celebra el don del Espíritu Santo. Este año la *Fiesta de Pentecostés es el 19 de mayo*, y celebraremos el *Sacramento de la Confirmación en la Misa de las 11:00 am.*

Para aquellos *'adultos'* que han sido *'Bautizados,'* que tal vez también han recibido la *'Primera Comunión,'* pero nunca han sido *'Confirmados,'* por favor comuníquese con el Padre Orlando en la Oficina Parroquial para obtener información adicional y requisitos. Esto es importante especialmente para aquellas personas a las que se les ha pedido que sean padrinos para la confirmación de otra persona, o si planean casarse en un futuro cercano. Necesitas ser un *"cristiano confirmado"* tú mismo, antes de que puedas ser padrino de alguien, o para casarte en la Iglesia Católica.

Gospel Luke 24:35-48

Only in Luke do we find this resurrection story that is built around the theme of a journey. This is a theme dear to the evangelist as he portrayed Jesus journeying to Jerusalem through the second half of his gospel. Now we are shown disciples coming away from Jerusalem full of disappointment and lacking in understanding. On their journey they are brought to see things differently by a Jesus they only finally recognize at the breaking of what the Emmaus journey is all about.

Every Christian must come to a resurrection faith, one that accompanies Jesus through from Good Friday to Easter Sunday. We are invited to understand through our prayerful reading of the scriptures and the events that occur 'on the road' of our lives that the risen Lord still walks with us and meets us, especially when we gather to break bread, that is share in the Eucharist.

Reflection

The first and second readings point to the danger of thinking that just because we belong to what we consider to be the 'true' religion we do not have to concern ourselves with how we live out that faith. Peter is speaking to his fellow-Jews beside the temple in Jerusalem, reminding them of the need for repentance Jesus today while John is writing to some smug Christians who feel that simply knowing Jesus is enough. The fact is that there must be a connection between what we believe and the way we live. Our faith must show itself in love.

The Emmaus story is a reminder that unfortunately, the story of Easter may remain just a retelling of some event from the distant past if we do not allow Jesus to show us how his resurrection is a source of life for us today. Its power is to be experienced in the ordinary events of life as we struggle to be faithful. However, it is often only with hindsight that we can see the ways the Lord has accompanied us on the road.

The Easter Season will carry us into the month of May, which is traditionally dedicated to our Blessed Mother. On the first Sunday of May, members of the Ecuadorian community will celebrate our Blessed Mother under her title, *"Our Lady of the Clouds,"* (*'Virgen de la Nube'*), and of course, on the second weekend of May, we'll honor our mother's as we celebrate *'Mother's Day!'*

Let's keep the spirit of Easter going! As St. Augustin is often quoted, *"We are an Easter people, and Alleluia is our song!"*
