

**Dia de La Ascension- Thursday
May 9, 2024**

Al final de este período de 40 días, Jesús ascendió al cielo. A esto lo llamamos la Ascensión.

La Biblia nos dice lo que sucedió ese día: En mi obra anterior, Teófilo, me ocupé de todo lo que Jesús había hecho y enseñado desde el principio hasta el día en que dio sus instrucciones a los apóstoles que había elegido por medio del Espíritu Santo, y fue llevado al cielo.

Se había mostrado vivo a ellos después de su Pasión por medio de muchas demostraciones: durante cuarenta días había continuado apareciendo a ellos y hablándoles del reino de Dios.

Mientras estaba a la mesa con ellos, les había dicho que no salieran de Jerusalén, sino que esperaran allí lo que el Padre había prometido. «Es», había dicho, «de lo que me habéis oído hablar:

Juan bautizó con agua, pero dentro de no muchos días vas a ser bautizado con el Espíritu Santo".

Y habiéndose reunido, le preguntaron: Señor, ¿ha llegado el momento de que restituyas el reino a Israel?

Él les respondió: "No os corresponde a vosotros saber los tiempos ni las fechas que el Padre ha decidido por su propia autoridad, sino que recibiréis el poder del Espíritu Santo que vendrá sobre vosotros, y entonces seréis mis testigos, no solo en Jerusalén, sino en toda Judea y Samaria, y hasta los últimos lugares de la tierra".

Al decir esto, se levantó mientras ellos miraban, y una nube lo quitó de su vista.

Todavía estaban mirando al cielo mientras él se iba, cuando de repente dos hombres vestidos de blanco estaban de pie junto a ellos, y dijeron: "¿Por qué estáis aquí los galileos que estáis aquí mirando al cielo? Este Jesús, que ha sido tomado de vosotros al cielo, volverá de la misma manera que le habéis visto ir al cielo. (Hechos de los Apóstoles 1:1-11)

**Ascension Day - Thursday
May 9, 2024**

At the end of this 40 day period, Jesus ascended into heaven. We call this the Ascension.

The Bible tells us what happened on that day: In my earlier work, Theophilus, I dealt with everything Jesus had done and taught from the beginning until the day he gave his instructions to the apostles he had chosen through the Holy Spirit, and was taken up to heaven.

He had shown himself alive to them after his Passion by many demonstrations: for forty days he had continued to appear to them and tell them about the kingdom of God.

While at table with them, he had told them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait there for what the Father had promised. 'It is', he had said, 'what you have heard me speak about:

John baptised with water but, not many days from now, you are going to be baptised with the Holy Spirit.'

Now having met together, they asked him, 'Lord, has the time come for you to restore the kingdom to Israel?'

He replied, 'It is not for you to know times or dates that the Father has decided by his own authority, but you will receive the power of the Holy Spirit which will come on you, and then you will be my witnesses not only in Jerusalem but throughout Judaea and Samaria, and indeed to earth's remotest end.'

As he said this he was lifted up while they looked on, and a cloud took him from their sight.

They were still staring into the sky as he went, when suddenly two men in white were standing beside them, and they said, 'Why are you Galileans standing here looking into the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will come back in the same way as you have seen him go to heaven.' (Acts of the Apostles 1:1-11)

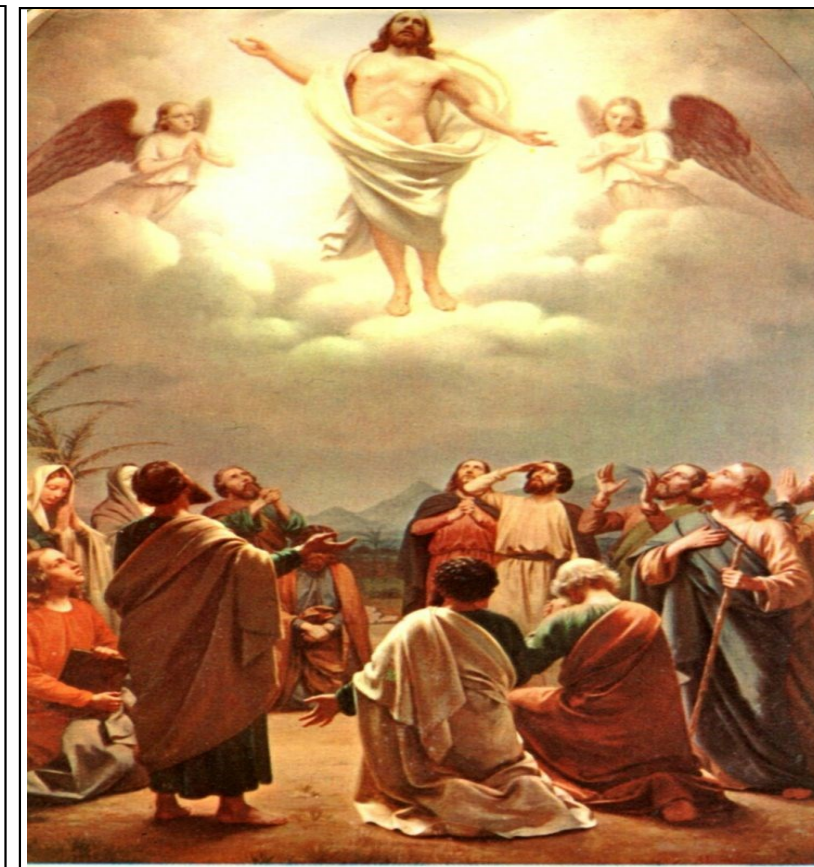

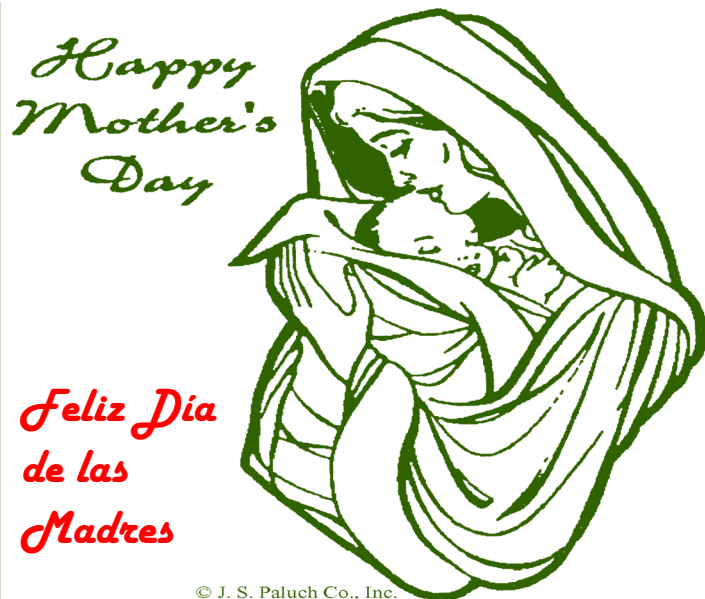

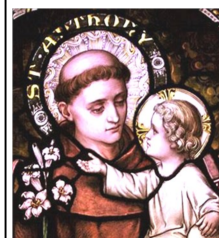
Called to Communion, Participation, and Mission
